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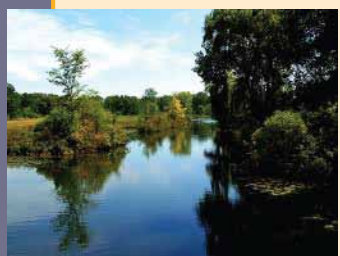


It Is Possible residential sober living homes are located in the center of the scenic Village of Milford near Central Park and have access to the beautiful Huron River. Our homes are conveniently situated within walking distance of

the Milford Counseling outpatient offices, approximately 15 weekly 12-step support group meetings, as well as job opportunities in the town and surrounding communities. Locations are easy to find with abundant parking and handicap accessibility. The locations are within walking distance of many outdoor physical activities that will enhance sober leisure activities such as: paved and off-road biking trails, hunting and fishing areas, canoeing and kayaking, state and county parks, cross country and downhill skiing and snowboarding, public basketball courts, volley ball courts, and tennis courts. In the winter the volley ball court is transformed into an ice rink for hockey and ice skating. We are around the corner and a few blocks from the local library and the YMCA where many other indoor



activities and classes are available. These homes are ideal for those who want the luxury of multiple amenities all within walking distance.



The homes include utilities, TV and cable services, house phone, cleaning supplies, appliances, kitchen supplies, trash pickup and curbside recycling, bedding and pillows, towels, coffee makers and filters, fully furnished common areas and bedrooms, washer and dryer, and outdoor smoking areas.

We have been very successful with alcohol, drug and behavioral addictions. We help support the recovering addict/alcoholic to properly utilize the 12 steps. We will work with the client on the barriers that have stood in the way of the development of an adequate sober support network. We provide assistance with life skills, boundaries, spirituality, health, employment, schooling, and self-esteem.

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
